PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

BLOOD THINNERS

- If you are on prescription anticoagulants (blood thinners) such as Coumadin, Plavix, Xeralto, etc. you **May** be asked to stop this prior to your surgical appointment.
- If asked to stop your blood thinner then we will need a written authorization from your medical doctor.

- You may continue your daily dose of Aspirin.

PRIOR TO SURGERY DAY

- Aspirin and Tylenol (Acetaminophen) are permitted.
- Try to limit over the counter (OTC) medication like Ibuprofen, Aleve, etc. as they may cause more bleeding
- Shower the morning of surgery. For scalp surgery, shampoo in the A.M. of surgery.
- Men should shave the day of facial surgery.
- Eat your usual meals the day of surgery.
- Inform us of all medical conditions such as cardiac disease (**PACEMAKER**, **HEART MURMUR**) diabetes, frequent infections and/or excessive bleeding following an injury or surgery.
- Do not wear a pullover shirt if having surgery on your scalp, face or neck.

AFTER CARE

- You will have stitches for up to 2 weeks.
- Keep area dry and pressure bandage in place for 24 hours. Afterwards you can shower but **NO** bathing, swimming, soaking the area in a hot tub, etc.
- Bandage will need to be changed **DAILY**.
- You should be able to drive yourself home the day of the procedure.
- Written wound care instructions will be provided to you on the day of the procedure.
